Parents May Request Teacher Information

The Every Student Succeeds Act of 2015 provides parents of students attending Title 1 schools the opportunity to request information about the professional qualifications of their child's teachers. Parents of elementary students may request in writing to the school principal information about their child's teacher including college/university degrees of certification held, subject area of the teacher's degree or certification, and Maryland certification status. Additionally, if your child is served by paraprofessionals, parents may request their professional qualifications.

Please return all emergency update forms, Choptank enrollment forms and Free and Reduced Meal forms (must submit every year).

School Safety Update

The Caroline County Public School system will continue to utilize the Raptor system to better allow us to track visitors in our schools and provide us with a safer, more monitored environment for our students and staff. Upon entering a Caroline County School, please present a valid state-issued ID (driver's license, state id card), which will be scanned into the system. Upon reading the information, Raptor will check national and local databases to identify those individuals that should not be allowed in our schools. Once entry is approved, Raptor will issue a badge that identifies the visitor, the date, and the purpose of his/her visit.

Parents are welcome to have lunch with their children at any time without advance notice. Check into the office upon arrival, present government issued ID and receive a visitor's sticker.
