### From Nurse Peggy SUN SAFETY

Scream for sunscreen! It's that time of year again- flowers are blooming, grass is growing and the sun is shining. The damage we do to our skin as children reflects the outcome as adults. Skin cancer is the most common and fastest growing cancer in the United States. There are more than 1 million new cases diagnosed each year. One in every five children grows up to develop one type of skin cancer. There are three types of skin cancer- Basal Cell, Squamous Cell and Melanoma. Basal cell and Squamous Cell are the most common type and are related to chronic sun exposure. Melanoma is a potential fatal type of skin cancer, which begins with melanocytes.

#### Things To Know-

1. Cover up wear light colored protective clothing
2. Use Sunscreen SPF #15 or greater apply 20-30 minutes before exposure. Reapply every 2 hours and immediately after swimming or sweating heavily.
3. Wear hats and make sure the brim covers your face and ears.
4. Use sunglasses to protect your eyes
5. Avoid sun exposure between 10am-4pm, which is when the rays are the strongest.
