## Fantastic Falcons

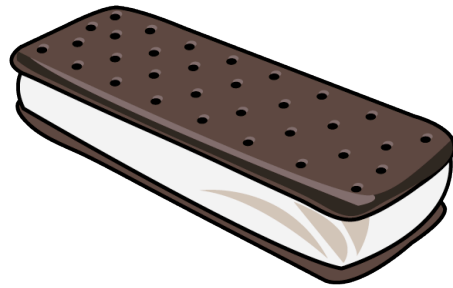
